### **RUN-OFF ELECTION VOTING:**

Election day voting will be conducted at the Election Commission Building, 649A Ouachita Ave., Fountain Lake Fire Department, 7146 Park Ave., and Lonsdale City Hall, 501 Cockrill St. Additional notices will contain other details, if necessary.

### **ELECTION OFFICIALS:**
