40 The total rate proposed above includes the uniform rate of tax (the "Statewide Uniform Rate") to be collected on all
41 taxable property in the State and remitted to the State Treasurer pursuant to Amendment No. 74 to the Arkansas
42 Constitution to be used solely for maintenance and operation of schools in the State. As provided by Amendment No. 74,
43 the Statewide Uniform Rate replaces a portion of the existing rate of tax levied by this School District and available for
maintenance and operation of schools in this District. The total proposed school tax levy of 39.8 mills includes 27.05
mills specifically voted for general maintenance and operation, 7.75 mills voted for debt service previously voted as a
continuing levy pledged for the retirement of existing bonded indebtedness, and 5.0 new debt service mills. The 5.0 new
debt service mills plus the existing 7.75 debt service mills now pledged for the retirement of existing bonded
indebtedness, which debt service mills will continue to retire the bonds to which now pledged, will be a
continuing debt service tax until the retirement of principal bonds to be issued in the principal amount of \$44,250,000,
and which will mature over a period of 30 years and will be used for the purpose of constructing and equipping a new
Elementary School and a new Workforce/Multi-purpose Facility having an office development; and constructing,
refurbishing, remodeling and equipping other school facilities. Any surplus revenues produced each year by the debt
service millage may be used by the District for other school purposes. The total proposed school tax levy of 39.8 mills
represents an increase of 5.0 mills from the rate presently being levied.
