NOTICE FOR ALL VOTERS

Photo Identification Required for Verification of Voter Registration (Act 633 of 2017)

The following forms of photo identification are acceptable to verify voter registration:

- (1) A document or identification card that satisfies all of the following conditions:
 - (a) Shows the name of the person to whom the document was issued;
 - (b) Shows a photograph of the person to whom the document was issued:
- (c) Is issued by the United States, the State of Arkansas, or an accredited postsecondary educational institution in the State of Arkansas; and
- (d) If displaying an expiration date, the document or card is not expired or expired no more than four (4) years before the date of the election in which the person seeks to vote. MUST SHOW ID first time voters must present unexpired identification.
- (2) Documents or Identification cards that comply with the above requirements for photo identification include, without limitation, the following:
 - (a) An Arkansas driver's license;
 - (b) A federal or Arkansas issued photo identification card;
 - (c) An Arkansas concealed handgun carry license;
 - (d) A United States passport;
- (e) An employee badge or identification document issued to any person by an accredited postsecondary educational institution in the State of Arkansas;
 - (f) A United States Military identification document;
- (g) A public assistance identification card if the card shows a photograph of the person to whom the document or identification card was issued; and
- (h) A voter identification card as provided under Act 633 of 2016 and rules propounded by the Secretary of State.

ANY VOTER NOT POSSESSING ACCEPTABLE IDENTIFICATION MAY SIGN AN OPTIONAL VERIFICATION OF IDENTITY AFFIRMATION, UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY, AND VOTE A PROVISIONAL BALLOT WHICH SHALL BE COUNTED AFTER REGISTRATION IS CONFIRMED.
