Notice is Hereby Given that by the virtue of the authority vested by the Constitution and the Laws of the State of Arkansas, I hereby proclaim, publish and make known to all legal voters within 70W Volunteer Fire Association in Garland County and Hot Spring County, AR, or Piney Volunteer Fire Association in Garland County, Arkansas; that an election will be held in Garland County, Arkansas for the purpose of electing to form separate Fire Protection Districts. The election will be held on Tuesday, July 09, 2019 between the hours of 7:30 AM and 7:30 PM in accordance with State Law.

Question 1

FOR or AGAINST the establishment of a fire protection district within designated portions of Garland County, and Hot Spring County, Arkansas, and the levy of assessed benefits on the real property in the district to finance the district.

Any Qualified Elector in Garland County, Arkansas, and Hot Spring County, Arkansas, residing within the 70W or Piney Volunteer Fire Departments designated area, may vote at the Early Voting Location or Polling Locations on Election Day.


